## OTHER STEPS TAKEN

- More than **400** banners on Disaster Preparedness Month were displayed in each nook and corner of the District.
- More than **500** posters and **2000** leaflets were distributed to the MCD offices. Most of these posters were displayed in the MCD Offices
- More than **500** posters and **2000** leaflets were distributed to the District medical officer for further distribution in to the DHS micro units
- Construction of the EOC (NE) has been completed and awaiting for inauguration
- More than **10000** leaflets and **5000** posters were distributed to various logical units like schools, RWAs etc
- Leaflets on Disaster Management were distributed door-to-door in Dilshad Garden Pocket A (**750** Families) and in Sri Ram Colony (Approx. **2200** Families) using the colony security Guards of the respective Pockets.
- TIFAC Film was screened in cable channels in Part of Dilshad Garden and M S park areas.
- TIFAC film was distributed to more than **150** logical units in the district.
- TIFAC film on disaster management had been screened in more than **175** meetings in the district during the month.
- Altogether **45000** leaflets, **22700** posters and more than **11750** books on disaster management as well as dos and don'ts were distributed free of cost to the stake holders and beneficiaries.
